To view both class and presentation of solos: \$15 adult \$8 student/child (Or \$10/\$5 for one session) Pay on the day AICD members free.

#### <u>Junior Awards</u> Rules and Conditions of Entry

- Candidates must register on arrival at least 30 minutes before the start.
- Candidates must attend the preliminary class

#### **Variations**

Candidates must prepare and perform a classical solo. Maximum length:

- 2 minutes for years 7 & 8
- 2 minutes for years 9 & 10

There are no set or prescribed solos

- Year 7 & 8 solos should be choreographed to suit to the age and standard of the dancer
- Year 9 & 10 students may perform a variation from classical repertoire

#### Please note

- Year 7 candidates: soft shoes (*only*)
- Years 8 & 9 candidates: soft shoes or pointe shoes (optional)
- Year 10 candidates: pointe shoes (*compulsory*)
- For the solos, traditional costumes may be worn or a simple version in a suitable style is equally accepted.

### <u>Senior Awards</u> <u>Rules and Conditions of Entry</u>

- Candidates must register on arrival at least 30 minutes before the start.
- Candidates must attend the preliminary class

Awards are offered to senior students aged 15 years and over. (Please note: Students aged 15 or over can only enter ONE category). All entrants are assessed on their classical ballet class work as well as their solo performance of a classical and a contrasting solo. Entrants are required to choose **a classical solo** from the following classical repertoire, which is to be performed in traditional costume. A second contrasting solo is the entrant's own choice.

**Second Variation of Own Choice** Entrants will be expected to perform a solo of their own choice which should not be a classical variation, but be choreographed in a contemporary style which contrasts with the entrant's classical variation. The solo must not be less than 1 minute in duration and is not to exceed 2 minutes.

## <u>Music</u>

- Candidates must supply their own music on a new CD (please avoid RW type)
- The CD must be clearly marked with the candidate's name and number and handed in when registering
- Any royalties that may be payable for the performance of recorded copyright material is the responsibility of the candidate.

## <u>General</u>

- No entry fees can be refunded unless the event is cancelled
- The use of video cameras and flash photography is not permitted in the studio
- The adjudicators' decision is final and no protests or correspondence will be entered into
- While AICD will endeavour to provide the safest possible environment, NO responsibility can be taken for accidental injury
